New York State Uniform Admission Test Deadlines for Regents / RCT Exams:
 Morning Exams = 10:00 a.m. Afternoon Exams = 2:00 p.m.
 Students arriving after these times will not be admitted to a Regents or RCT examination.

- On June 19th – 21st the Middle/High School cafeteria will be open for breakfast and lunch with a menu that will vary day to day.
